DS/PR has attached chat logs from Manning's personal laptop. These chat logs contain information that Army CID believes describes sensitive classified information. DS/PR is providing this information for review to allow the readers to see some of the text of the chat logs that provides evidence that information was transferred to WikiLeaks.
